The decision was made to construct the building in two 48 foot sections, to make a 96 foot wide building. The complexity of the area warranted this decision. With M-57 on the south and warehouses and the ready-mix plant to the north the ability to swing a 96 foot truss wasn't feasible. The new warehouse gives Swartzmiller Lumber 8,000 square feet to stock all sizes of dimensial treated lumber, wood decking, composit decking, finish grade plywood, construction grade plywood, OSB and a ton of other sheet goods and lumber products.

The North end of the building has a new 22 foot door opening, which will allow customers with large trucks the ability to drive in, pull their order, make a complete loop around and exit. This entrance will also give accessibility to the store for handicapped customers.

Swartzmiller Lumber hopes to have the new warehouse completed and operation by the New Year and they are excited to get feeback from their customers.
