



## **Infection Control Plan For Fireworks In Showboat Park 2021**

In an effort to help control the spread of COVID-19 at the July 1, 2021 event, Fireworks in Showboat Park, hosted by the Chesaning Chamber of Commerce, the following mitigation strategies will be implemented:

### **Event Hygiene Procedures:**

- A schedule for increased, routine cleaning to disinfect common spaces will be made for the duration of the event.
- Additional hand sanitizing stations with hand sanitizers that are at least 60% alcohol will be available in the food vendor area.
- PPP including disposable masks and gloves, as well as hand sanitizer, will be made available to all event volunteers.

### **Food and Beverage Service:**

- Vendors are required to hold all local, county and state licenses required for their operation and are asked to follow local health department guidelines for infection control.
- Physical distancing will be encouraged in areas where lines form
- Due to the nature of the event and the large spaces provided for picnicking inside of Showboat Park, designated seating areas are unnecessary.

### **Face Masks:**

- Wearing of facemasks is not currently required in outdoor spaces, however if the mandates are updated prior to the event, signage will reflect the current recommendations

### **Physical Distancing Protocols:**

- As this is an event where participants pay per vehicle as they drive-in, congestion and physical distancing in lines at the gate is not a concern.
- 6 foot markers where lines occur at vendor booths will be used if current health department mandates require it.

### **Self-Screening Practices:**

- Individuals, including employees and volunteers, will be asked to conduct self-screening for COVID-19 symptoms before attending the event. (The free MI Symptoms tool can be used to complete self-screening for COVID-19 symptoms.)
- Individuals, including employees and volunteers, will be asked not to participate while symptomatic (even with a negative COVID-19 test or fully-vaccinated against COVID-19).

### **Communications Strategy:**

- Signage will be used if required by current MDHHS guidelines regarding COVID-19 mitigation measures.
- Regular PA announcements will be made regarding COVID-19 mitigation measures and other event rules.
- A list of all nearby sites to receive a COVID-19 test will be provided to all individuals who attend the event if requested.
