[Saginaw, MI] – United Financial Credit Union made the holidays a little brighter for the CAN Council & CASA of the Great Lakes Bay Region. The credit union raised \$1,000 for the 6th Annual CASA Christmas fundraiser. The money and items donated went towards helping 71 kids that are currently in the CASA program. United Financial collected donations at all six locations.

What is the CAN Council?

The CAN Council Great Lakes Bay Region is building communities where children are free from abuse and neglect. They sponsor several programs in the community; Child Abuse Prevention Education (CAPE), Children's Advocacy Center (CAC), CASA of Saginaw County, Community Outreach and Public Awareness

What is the CASA of the Great Lakes Bay Region?

Court Appointed Special Advocates are highly trained volunteers serving as the voice for children who are in the court system due to abuse and neglect.

Each CASA volunteer advocates on behalf of one child or family at a time, as opposed to the full caseloads managed by DHHS workers and lawyer-guardians ad litem. These volunteers stay with each case until it is closed and the child or sibling group is placed in a safe, permanent home.
